- -Permits can only be issued through the mail.
- -All permits are valid for 12 months from date of issue.
- -Please print clearly or type.
- -The permit holder must be an individual. Company names are not allowed.
- -Please include apartment numbers, complete zip codes (zip plus four), and telephone area codes.
- -Driver's license number is for identifying Permit Holder Applicants with similar names.
- -Two additional contact persons are required in the event the permit holder cannot be contacted.
- -Renewal notices are mailed to permit holder 30 days prior to expiration date.
- -Submit a separate application and fee for each alarm system on your property.

## FALSE ALARM FEES

Commissioners Court Order, establishes the following fees for false alarms. Fees must be paid before a permit can be issued/ renewed.

NO PERMIT: Citation

FALSE ALARMS: Each alarm user is allowed five false Burglary, Panic/Robbery or false Fire alarms during the 12

month permit cycle. Service fees for excessive false alarms will be assessed at \$75.00.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to have a valid alarm permit can result in fines from \$50.00-\$500.00 plus Court Cost for each false alarm. Alarm sites with local alarm systems (non-monitored) are required to have a valid alarm system permit. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to provide the permit number to their alarm and/or monitoring company. All your information will be treated as confidential.
