PERMIT FEES

Section 25-58 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio establishes the following fees for permits:

All permits are valid for **one (1) year** from the date of issue. Renewal notices are mailed to permit holders 30 days prior to the permit expiration date.

FALSE ALARM FEES

Section 25-57 and 25-66(a) of the City Code of the City of San Antonio establishes the following fees for false alarms. Fees must be paid before a permit can be issued/renewed.

NO PERMIT:	\$25.00 for each un-permitted alarm activation.
BURGLARY:	There is no service fee for the first three false alarms. A \$50 service fee for the 4 th & 5 th false alarms, \$75 for the 6 th & 7 th false alarms, and \$100 for the 8 th and successive false alarms within 12-month permit cycle.
ROBBERY: (Includes panic and duress alarms)	There is no service fee for the first false alarm. \$100 for the 2 nd and 3 rd false alarms. \$250 for the 4 th and successive false alarms within 12-month permit cycle.
FIRE:	There is no service fee for the first three false alarms. \$50 for the 4 th false alarm. \$100 for the 5 th and successive false alarms within the 12-month permit cycle.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to have a valid alarm permit can result in fines from \$300-\$500 for each false alarm. Alarm sites with local alarm systems (non-monitored) are required to have a valid alarm system permit. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to provide the permit number to their alarm and/or monitoring company.
